Fine Wines - White

Top end wines and small parcels that we mark up very reasonably – some real bargains.

Roero Arneis 2018 Paolo Conterno, Langhe – 59.00

Arneis the favourite grape variety of the Piedmontese and Paolo Conterno one of the masters of Barolo and Nebiolo together make this a fantastic wine. Straw yellow color, with delicate greenish reflections to the eye. The nose is floral and fruity, characterized in particular by hints of lily of the valley and pineapple, then enriched with important citrus nuances. The mouth is consistent with the nose, flowing and fragrant, with good persistence.

Saint Peray 2016 Alain Voge, Rhone – 63.00

100% Marsanne from one of the best wine makers in the Rhone valley. The wine is produced biodynamically and matured in oak. It is exceptionally full and rich in aromas, with a vivacious mineral quality to liven up its marzipan and vanilla notes and give the wine length and ageing potential.

Chablis, Fourchaume, 1er Cru, Vieilles Vignes, 2017 Le Domaine d'Henri - 65.00

From vines planted in 1970 this lovely Chablis has fine pale colour with a very charming nose, with steel behind. Very racy, white fruit, extremely impressive. superb length. This vintage with its smoky nose and tantalisingly massive juiciness and fruit seems one of the most exciting' – Jancis Robinson

Lingua Franca, Avni Chardonnay 2016 Willamette Valley, Oregon - 69.00

Fresh, cool citrus and barely ripe fruit aroma, with hints of sea breeze, musk, and vanilla bean. Similar flavours with plenty of acidity, and a streak of salinity. General sense of purity and transparency; and just plain tasty. A touch of silky richness. It has a very distinct and persistent note of chalk/slate on the finish, which makes it very interesting

Puligny-Montrachet, Les Reuchaux, 2017 Boyer- Martenot - 72.00

2016 was an absolute classic vintage for white Burgundy. The wines have excellent balance and harmony underpinned by beautiful minerality – nothing overblown

Nuits St George 1er Cru Les Terres Blanches 2014 Do- maine Dublere - 77.00

From one of the best of the new Burgundy producers this is lovely. The palate is rich with a noticeable freshness. The Chardonnay component brings structure and a lovely minerality, and the pinot blanc adding complexity.

Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Morgeot, 2016/17 Fontaine-Gagnard - 86.00

The world wide demand for top white Burgundy knows no bounds, but one can still find small pockets of excellent Chassagne and here is our pick – classic and peerless

Fine Wines - Red

Top end wines and small parcels that we mark up very reasonably – some real bargains.

Bandol Rouge 2015 Domaine Terrebrune - 63.00

This is a fantastic vintage from one the best producers. Classic Bandol, a rich, meaty wine with black fruits, prunes, leather and cedar, layers of complexity and a velvety texture.

Petite Sirah 2016 Ridge Vineyards Sonoma, USA - 65.50

Deep, luscious and intense, The 2016 is captivating from the very first taste. The purity of the fruit is remarkable. Dark inky purple with thick legs. The nose has dark fruit, a little herb and some subtle vanilla. A thick coating of lush fruit coats the mouth. Nice acidity and a long finish.

Chateau Lanessan 2008 Haut Medoc- 67.00

Chateau Lanessan is situated at the intersection of St Julien and Haut Medoc. 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot with a smattering of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. The 2008 Château Lanessan is herbaceous, rich, and fruity, with good tannic backbone. A good medium-bodied Médoc, it is a great claret at a very reasonable price.

Beaune 1er Cru Les Blanchés Fleurs 2015

Domaine Dublere – 75.00

One of the rising stars of Burgundy, Domaine Dublere have produced a lovely wine - complex red fruit notes – cherries, sous bois and a slightly earthy minerality. On the palate good body and weight for the vintage, with a surprisingly fresh and crisp acidity

Volnay Santenots 1er Cru 2014

Thierry & Pascale Matriot - 75.00

Drinking beautifully now this is a great Volnay - elegant with dark berry fruits on the nose and a minerality on the palate.

Côte-Rôtie 2013 Saint Cosme - 73.00

The Syrah grape is at it's most silkily elegant in the appellation, such is the finesse, verging on the sensuous, it is one of the worlds truly great wines. Smoke, boysenberry, earth; gravel and soil, intense, sustained, very good indeed

Chateau Potensac 2003 Medoc - 78.00

Managed by Jean-Hubert Delon of Léoville Las Cases, this is without equal in the Medoc appellation. It shows breeding, depth of flavor, beautifully crafted tannins and fine, rich fruit without the overripeness so characteristic of 2003. With its structure, acidity and delicious fruit, this will age as well as any wine from a more classy appellation.

Brunello di Montalcino 2009 Gaja – 79.00

100% Sangiovese. The 2009 Brunello di Montalcino is rich and intense both in terms of appearance and bouquet. Aromas peel back with delicate layers of dark fruit, pressed rose petal, baking spice and grilled herb.

Pommard Rugiens Bas, Premier Cru 2010

Domaine Billard Gonnet – 96.00

Old-school Burgundy. Pale garnet. Powerful aromas of cherries, plums and earth. Dry, acidity and tannins robust, lots of body. Rounded mouthfeel with iron-like minerality. Concentrated red fruit, very long and powerful finish with great balance of fruit, earth and spice.

Chateau Rauzan-Segla 2008 Margaux - 128.00

Segla produces some of the finest Margaux in any vintage. Charming nose of creamy cassis fruit. The palate shows a fresh, vibrant fruit character with black and red fruit spreading across the mid-palate. Beautifully textured with fresh acidity and fine-grained tannin giving length to this appealing Rauzan.

Chateaufeuf du Pape 1998 Chateau de Beaucastel - 130.00

Château de Beaucastel has long been considered one of the great wines of France. An exceptional vintage. A very hot summer, great weather conditions until the end of the harvest
